PLEASE FOLLOW DIMENSIONS or will be disqualified from going on to District Competition

1. Create a hand drawn poster to promote your fair. Name and **date of fair Sept 27,28,29th, 2024**, must be clearly shown on poster.
- 2. Poster size: Minimum - approximately 22cm X 28cm, without border Maximum - approximately 28cm X 44cm, without border**
3. Each entry must be centered on a CARDSTOCK or BRISTOL BOARD backing exposing approximately 5.5cm border on all four sides.
4. Name of fair, District 13, contact person, owner of poster and complete mailing address must be clearly labelled on the back of each entry
