RULES and REGULATIONS

- 1. HOURS – All exhibits must be dropped off by 11:00 AM, Friday of the Fair. Thursday – the building is open from 6 pm – 9 pm to accept exhibits. All entries remain on display until Sunday of the fair. PICK UP FOR ITEMS AND PRIZE MONEY IS SUNDAY FROM 5:15 PM – 6:30 PM. NO VEHICLE ENTRY ALLOWED ON SUNDAY.**
- 2. Open to any child currently in Grade 8 and under as of September of the current school year**
- 3. A membership number is required (no fee) and a Junior Fair entry form must be filled out before any prize money can be forwarded. Please use a separate entry form for Junior Fair Entries.** If your child is entering in adult competitions – they must go to the office and pay membership. Please use a separate form for those entries as Junior fair keeps their entry forms. **The same membership number can be used for different buildings.**
- 4. On the Entry Tag, enter the child's First and Last name and Membership Number. If only entering Jr. Fair – a membership number will be given to you in the Junior Fair Building.**
- 5. All entries must be the child's own work with a limit of one entry per section per child. A child may enter their age category and higher age group categories if wish.**
- 6. Baking Exhibits can be removed on Saturday at 5:00 p.m.** Please make arrangements for someone to pick up your entry. *If the entry is not picked up, it will be discarded.*
- 7. The entry form is to be left at the Junior Fair building when dropping off the entry.**
No entries can be accepted after the judging has started.
- 8. Please make arrangements for someone to pick up your child's entries and money if you are not available to do so. Parents will be required to sign for the amount at this time to ensure validity. No mailing of prize money.**

The other agricultural societies may send their second-place winner into the district competition. An exhibitor may only enter into one district competition.
